UPCOMING SUMMER EVENTS AT THE YMCA

Warsaw, IN – This summer, the **Kosciusko Community YMCA** will be offering youth activities and camps from June to August. Upcoming camps include tumbling, preschool sports, volleyball, boys gymnastics, preschool fitness, basketball, and competitive swimming. Camp Little Eagle will also be running every week throughout the summer, Monday through Friday 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Boys Gymnastics Camp will be from July 7th to the 9th, 10:00-11:30 a.m. for ages 4 to 10. Boys will learn basic tumbling and explore different skills on the vault and uneven bars.

Sports of all Sorts Camp for kids ages 5 to 7, July 12th to the 16th, 11:00-11:45 a.m. will give kids an opportunity to learn about all types of sports. Volleyball Camp July 12th-16th, 1:00-3:00 p.m., will teach kids ages 10 to 15 fundamental volleyball skills like proper bumping, setting, and spiking techniques.

A Tumbling Clinic July 21st to 22nd, 1:00-2:30 p.m. for ages 6 and up will help cheerleaders and gymnasts of all skill levels refine and upgrade their tumbling skills. Preschool Fitness Camp for ages 3 to 6, July 19th- 23rd, 2:30-3:00 p.m. will get kids started on the road to a healthy lifestyle making exercise fun and exciting.

Basketball Camp August 2nd- 6th, 10:30a.m.-12:00 p.m. for ages 5 to 7 and 1:00-3:00 p.m. for ages 13 and up will include drills and skill development, followed by competitive games and scrimmages.

Sharks Swim Camp, with two levels, Beginner and Advanced, will be for swimmers age 5 and up. Swimmers must have a basic knowledge of all four competitive strokes. Swim Camp will be August 2nd-6th.
