## Activities for Week 1: Eyeballs and Goo What's Inside You?

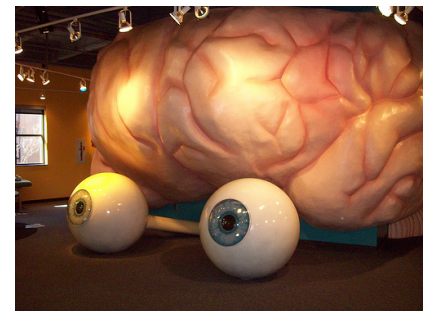
